


# Global Perspectives Film Series

In *Deaf Jam*, Aneta Brodski seizes the day. Aneta is a deaf teen introduced to American Sign Language (ASL) Poetry, who then boldly enters the poetry slam scene, becoming one of the first deaf poets to compete in a spoken-word slam. In a wondrous twist, Aneta, an Israeli immigrant living in the Queens section of New York City, meets Tahani, a hearing Palestinian slam poet. The two young women embark on a collaboration/performance duet - creating a new form of slam poetry that speaks to both the hearing and the Deaf.
